122 responses




65 waiting until the start of Fall Sports.

19 using live feed such as zoom or google meets/hangouts


If you held tryouts via submitting a video, please rate how it went. 1 to 5 (5 being it went awesome)

Tryouts went well from a judging/coaching standpoint. It was a little more stressful for the girls to use this format simply because they re-recorded many times. The format was useful in seeing the skills of each girl, I think it lacked in allowing you to see who they really are as a person. If this were to ever happen again I™d go with a live remote tryout.

We had student-athletes submit tryout videos to the coaching staff. We felt it went very well. One thing we did was eliminate tumbling due to liability issues.

We are waiting till we can have the kids in a space for a normal tryout.

We are in the middle of trying to hire a varsity coach, so until that happens we do not have a coach (junior high coach also resigned). So in a holding pattern at this point.

Have not held tryouts yet. Looking to by the end of May.

We have not held them yet, but our plan is to do video tryouts

This will take place June 1-8, 2020. Teams announced June 9, 2020

Our cheer coaches are talking with other programs to see if the online tryout is successful

Had to cut 14 cheerleaders. The positive is it's over the negative couple of disgruntled parents think it's unfair and thinks we should have waited.

Really went well with tryouts and have yet to hear any complaints. We have our sheets and inf to share should anyone want it.

Planning to do tryouts in July or August based on when school facilities open again. Thanks,

We plan on doing a video submission, but are waiting to do so.

Many of the girls wanted to try out but had trouble getting their videos to the coach.

We always do cheer tryouts with a start date the same as our other Fall sports, August 1st

We are currently organizing the google documents to see who is interested and Then we will proceed with the video tryouts

we're currently having cheerleaders submit videos with results getting posted next Monday. To this point, we've had no issues

Just waiting for the right time.

Have not held them yet, we are doing them the first week in June.

Do end of May, information sent out in Zoom meeting with parents and students.

We haven't completed them yet but are scheduled for week of May 18

We used BAND App, the cheer coach thought it was great. One think we learned was to be very specific in skills needed to make each level then email an evaluation to each athlete with specific feed back as to why you made the choice you did.

We are waiting for an in person tryout. I do not want a kids internet quality to impact their tryout. With camps closing there is no real hurry to have these completed.

We are doing a combination of things (couldn't really answer this in multiple choice question format). We had a parent meeting via zoom (just our coaches and parents). They will do their typical "clinics" via zoom where older girls (usually graduating seniors or returning alum) will show cheers and help critique those trying out to be prepared for actual tryouts. Actual tryouts will be completed via zoom (the coach will record the video to be able to accurately critique each girl) and individual submissions of cheers. Our cheer coach has lots of experience with teaching classes (prior to covid-19) via zoom, so this is actually a preferred process for her.

Here is my positive - cheer does not fall under my supervision. It is left to the principal. Cheerleading is still recognized during our sports award days, but I do not have to handle discipline or tryouts

Our tryouts were held the week before this happened

We are going to wait and see if we are having fall sports before having tryouts. Hopefully we are able to get in the building sometime this summer.

We are going to hold them as soon as we get the go ahead to get kids back on school campus.

No negatives. If you go with this, I recommend that you use our plan as I described to you.

We are in the process of hiring a cheerleading advisor. Advisor hopes to hold one via virtual tryout. She feels as if it is necessary to hold tryouts now to help with summer fundraisers and to order and get uniforms.

Still finalizing the plan but this is our best option as we don't want to wait to late into the summer.
